- Each year, 30,000 BUDISSA bags are delivered, about 2,000 km in length
- more than 1.000 machines have been built so far
- Today, more than 100 million tonnes of feed and grain are stored in bags
- Distribution throughout Europe, almost everywhere, we were the first and today we distribute in over 30 countries worldwide
